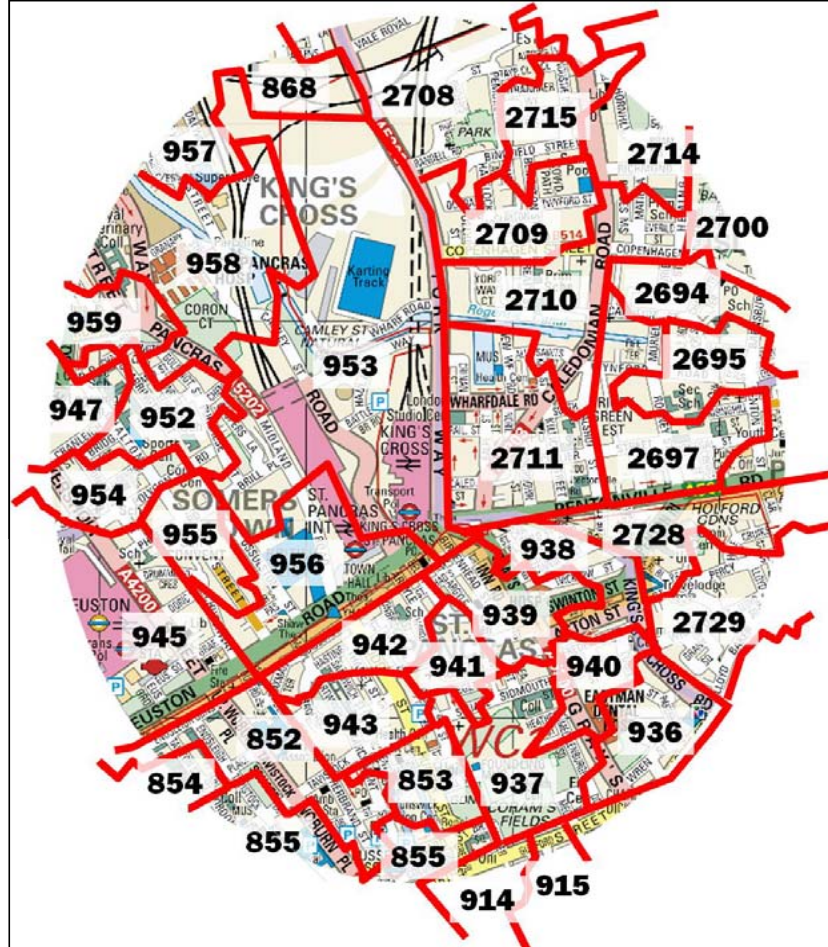

There are 37 'super output areas' that make up King's Cross. These are shown (roughly) on the map and are used to give very localised statistics.

Of the 37 areas of KX, 34 fall into the top 10% most deprived on the basis of air quality and road traffic accidents. 33 are in the top 10% most deprived on the basis of household overcrowding, homelessness and ability to afford owner-occupation and 10 fall into the top 10% on the basis of income.

Areas of Kings Cross fall into the top 10% most deprived in the country for crime, employment, health & disability, housing & services, income, outdoor & indoor living environment and wider barriers.
